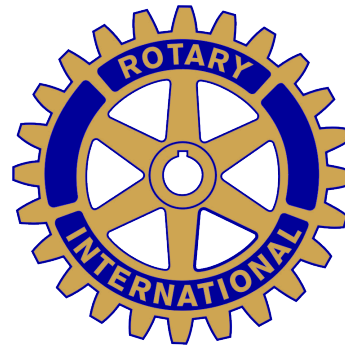
The objective of the course is to take young people who show some element of leadership potential and to develop their initiative, self reliance, good citizenship, leadership and team working qualities.

- Mock Interview Support



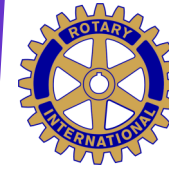

## About RYLA

RYLA weekends take place at Avon Tyrell, near Bransgore in the New Forest. Further information about Avon Tyrell can be found on their website [www.avontyrell.org.uk](http://www.avontyrell.org.uk)

The course is aimed at 16 and 17 year olds- young people. An 18 year old may be accepted if there are insufficient suitable candidates in the younger age groups. The usual number of young people selected for each course is about 24 and participants come from all parts of our Rotary District.

The course is designed to develop leadership potential and those selected will be able to demonstrate some 'track record' or potential as a leader.

## How to Apply

Letters are sent to the head teacher of all the local senior schools in February/ March of each year inviting applications.

Applicants are then invited along for a mini-interview with Rotarians of the Salisbury club. On the basis of this the club will



nominate the chosen applicants. The number of places offered each year is dependent on the funds available.

Usually Salisbury Rotary nominates 2 young people but using close ties to other Rotary Clubs it is sometimes possible to obtain additional places.
