Our route takes you from Salisbury to Winchester along the ancient Clarendon Way with a few extra turns here and there to make up a full 26.2 miles. More than 90% is off road, with the trail following country tracks and paths many of which have not changed since being travelled by the ancient Kings and Queens of England.

Our marathon event was first run in 1998. It was founded by Paul Elderkin, a keen runner and member of a local Hash House Harriers Club. Since 2013 the event has been managed by the Rotary Clubs of Winchester and Salisbury . All money raised will be given to good causes. You also have the opportunity to raise extra sponsorship for your own chosen charity. We hope that you will be able to join us this year to help make the Clarendon Marathon even more successful and raise money for a wide range of charities.



The entry fee, inclusive of medal and tshirt, is £40 per person for the full marathon and £30 for the half marathon
